## **Student Promotion Policy**

For students in Grades Young Fives through Sixth, an accumulated grade of seventy (70%) percent must be earned in order to advance to the next grade level.

For students in Grades Seventh and Eighth, an accumulated grade of seventy (70%) percent must be earned in each core course. Failure to achieve seventy (70%) percent in three out of four core courses will result in retention.

For students in Grades Ninth through Twelfth, a grade of sixty (60%) percent must be earned in order to pass each class.

Special Education students will be promoted or retained according to their Individual Education Plans (IEP's).

The Board of Directors reserves the right to promote students who do not meet the above requirements due to dire or extenuating circumstances.

This policy will take effect beginning the second semester of the 2004/2005 school year.

Starting in 2004/2005 school year, students in Grades Young Fives through Eighth will be promoted or retained based on an accumulated second semester grade.
